


Lunch at The Fox and Hounds




You are warmly invited to join your friends of the Rover Car Club of SA to Rove 2020 which will be held on our beautiful Fleurieu Peninsula centred in historic Victor Harbor, over the weekend of October 23 to 26, 2020.

Situated on one of the world's most stunning coastlines, the former whaling town of Victor Harbor is a relaxed seaside retreat with a historic main street and a coastline dominated by a huge rock outcrop called the Bluff. Offshore is Granite Island, connected to Victor Harbor by a causeway, strewn with giant granite boulders and home to a colony of penguins.

Things to do and activities abound when you stay in Victor Harbor. Ride the iconic Horse Drawn Tram across to Granite Island; catch one of the heritage Steamranger trains that travel along the scenic coastline; investigate the South Australian Whale Centre and the Encounter Coast Discovery Centre.

Explore the natural surrounds with miles of sandy beaches, rugged cliffs, cliff top trails, coastal bikeways, flora and fauna parks. Alternatively, explore the antique and fashionable shops in Victor Harbor, or the gourmet cafes and restaurants or award winning wineries. Spot seals, penguins, pods of dolphins, pelicans and a wide variety of other native wildlife. The choices are many.....
